ii) Develop and implement a multi-year strategy to seismically mitigate all schools with a "High" (H1, H2, or H3) government rating.

BC Hydro requires a statutory right-of-way for their infrastructure to facilitate the installation of field lights on the south all-weather sports field at Burnaby North Secondary School.


